



THE OLD AND NEW VIBES OF THE JEWISH DISTRICT

Built in 1859 in Moorish style, the **DOHÁNY STREET SYNAGOGUE** is the largest in Europe and the second largest in the world with its capacity to seat 3,000 people. The synagogue's size demonstrates the significance and the high economic as well as cultural standards of the Budapest Jewry of the age. It is still predominantly a venue of worship but it also houses cultural programmes. The guided tour of the Synagogue will start at 10.00 am on Sunday, September 8, and will include the Heroes' Temple, the Raoul Wallenberg Memorial Park and the graveyard.



After the one-hour tour in the Synagogue, we will make a **WALK IN DISTRICT 7** which today is the heart of Budapest's nightlife, giving home to various ruin pubs and clubs.

We will visit the most symbolic ruin pub – and the very first – **SZIMPLA KERT**. This world-famous club attracts visitors from all over the world. On Sunday mornings, however, it dedicates its unique scene to the local population of downtown Budapest, giving home to a farmers' market.



The Jewish district is the home of various restaurants and bistros. Should you want to continue the core program with a brunch or lunch here, we will be happy to assist you to find a great place for a seated lunch or enjoy the multiple street-food options of the neighbourhood.
