Autonomy

- When autonomous, individuals experience their behaviour as an expression of the self.
- ‘I am the causal agent of my own life’.
- Self-regulation: this presupposes you know this self, that you are aware of your values, that you are aware of what you stand for.





Participation in asynchronous digital knowledge flows contributes to the discovery of the self

priming: 3 tips

- ✓ ask the participants to do something
- ✓ ask that on time
- ✓ start the gathering referring to the participants' input

Purpose = greater good

≠ objectives

why – why – why

→ value / belief

Purpose = greater good

make this explicit before the gathering + at the start

2. Set up your interaction carefully.






